How to be a good fairy spotter

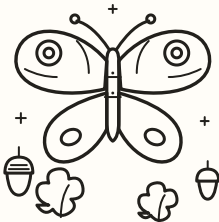

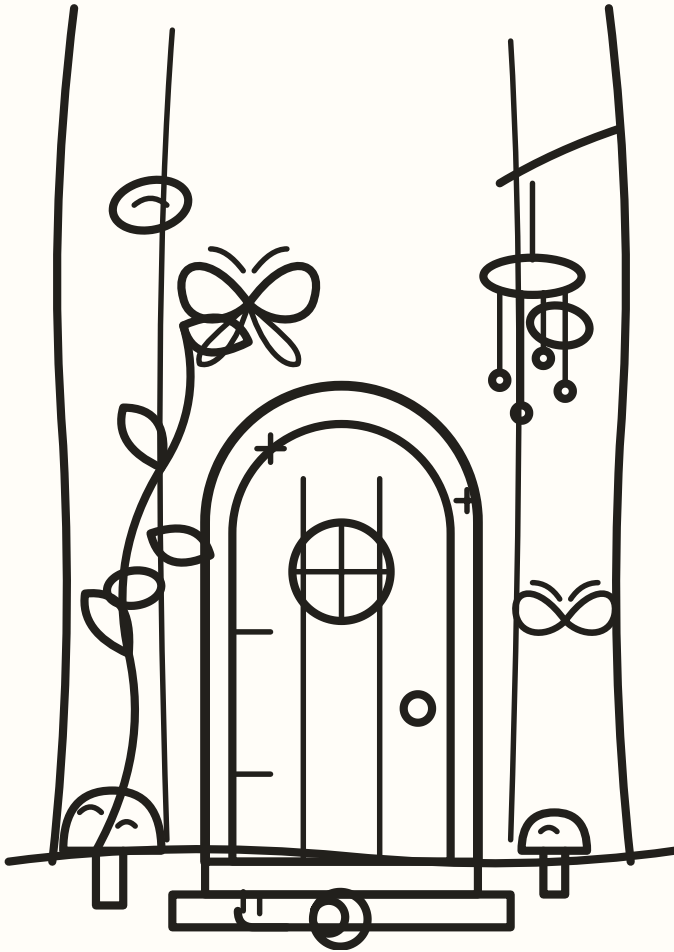


Colour the butterfly

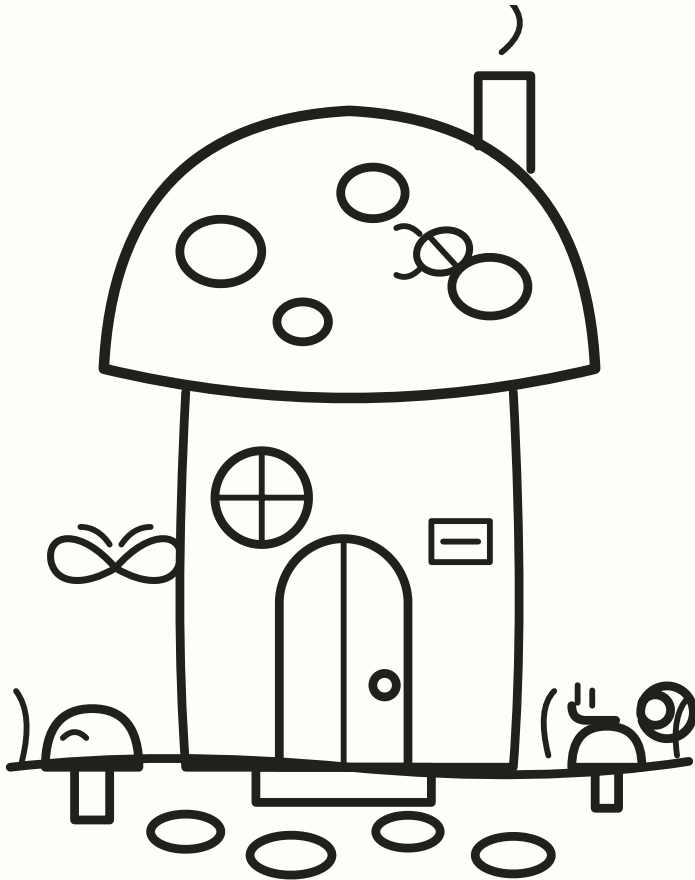
He walks the trail at dusk, lighting up all the little windows. What colour is his hat?
